

ALL DOGS PARKOUR SPECIAL 10TH ANNIVERSARY EVENT TENS TITLE

Entries for the Special 10th Anniversary Event (the Tens Title) are now open and may be submitted through October 31, 2026.

The Tens Title may be used towards your Renaissance Performance Sport Trifecta titles for ADP, if you submit all Tens entries prior to the Trifecta closing date (September 15, 2026).

ELIGIBILITY:

Dogs must be registered with All Dogs Parkour to participate. The Registration Form is on the Get Started page of the website.

ADP RULES AND GUIDELINES:

If you are new to ADP, please read the Rules and Guidelines (Get Started page on the website). Except as stated otherwise in this document, all the ADP rules and guidelines apply and entries will be judged accordingly. Please be especially aware of the equipment and leash rules as well as the rule limiting jump heights and when to support the dogs coming off an EF.

If the off leash options apply (see last two paragraphs of the Off Leash Options section of the R&G, page 7-2), you must hold the harness handle or a leash tab to spot and/or support your dog in all situations in which a leash is otherwise required. If the judge deems the exercise was not done safely and/or in accordance with the R&G, the entry will be an NQ. TITLE AND AWARD:

There is one title, which is ADP-10. Three qualifying entries are required to earn the title.

Teams earning the title will receive a title certificate by email and a double flat ribbon.

EFs:

Except for Category B (see TENS CATEGORIES, below), handlers may use any EFs found at or brought to the location(s) used for each entry. EFs may be assembled in one place or may be used in a variety of places. EFs may be used for multiple exercises, but each use must be a different exercise and must look

different from the other exercises with that EF. If you have multiple dogs, they may use the same EFs and do the same exercises.

EXERCISE CRITERIA:

Exercises need not meet the ADP exercise list criteria. Jumps may be lower than hock height, for example. Except for Category A, exercises may be original creations, such as backing over an EF. Unlimited Landscape/Hardscape exercises may be used. Unless otherwise specified in the Tens Category options, EFs may be used for multiple exercises, but each use must be a different exercise and must look different from the other exercises with that EF. If you have multiple dogs, they may use the same EFs and do the same exercises.

Exercises that do not meet ADP exercise list criteria, modifications of on-list exercises, and handler created exercises must be labeled in your entry as “Off-List” or “OL”.

TENS CATEGORIES:

There are four categories. For each entry, choose one category. You may use the same or different categories for each your three entries.

CATEGORY A: SINGLE EXERCISE, TEN PERFORMANCES

Choose one exercise from the ADP Exercise Descriptions Document. It can be from any of the exercise lists, including the Special Division list. Your entry will consist of ten performances of the exercise using different EFs for each performance. Although original creations cannot be used for this option, off-list performance of an exercise from the document is permitted. Examples are Jump Clean Low (Off-List) or Between Wide (Off-List).

If Category A is chosen for multiple legs, a different exercise must be used for each leg.

CATEGORY B: TEN LOCATIONS

Your entry will consist of one performance of one exercise in ten different locations. You need not use the same exercise in each location, although you can. There is no limit on the number of times that an exercise can be used in your entry. Exercises may include original creations (off-list exercises).

EFs may not be brought to the locations. Each EF used must "live" at the location.

If Category B is chosen for multiple legs, different exercises must be chosen if a location is repeated.

CATEGORY C: NOVEL USES WITH TEN DIFFERENT EFs

Using 10 different EFs (or related sets of EFs, such as a set of cones or a table and chairs), do the ADP Novel Uses exercise but with a minimum of two and a maximum of four exercises per EF.

The same number of exercises must be used within each entry. If you choose to do three exercises, that is how many you will do with each EF (or related set of EFs) in your entry.

Each set of Novel Uses must be different from the others in the entry. You may repeat exercises, but the complete set with each EF must not be the same as with any other EF in the entry.

If Category C is chosen for multiple legs, you must use a different number of Novel Uses exercises for each entry.

CATEGORY D: TEN SEQUENCES

Your entry will consist of ten sequences. Each sequence must have the same number of exercises with a minimum of two exercises per sequence.

You may repeat exercises, but each sequence must be different from the others in the entry.

If Category D is chosen for multiple legs, you must use a different number of exercises for the sequences in each entry.

ENTRY FEE:

The entry fee for the Tens title is \$10 per leg. Retries are the same (\$10).
